Baptist Church members meet to celebrate 77th birthday of the church's founding. It was founded June 30, 1888 when J. B. Duncan and A. J. Marshall met to study the formation of the church.

When first organized, the congregation met about one mile south of Bradley in a building which served as both a church and school. That building burned and a secondary building was erected.

The old community building still stands and is being used as a Methodist Church.

The present Baptist Church was built in 1957. Some former ministers are:
