RESOLUTION NO. 2023- 1

A RESOLUTION OF THE TOWN OF BRADLEY ("BRADLEY") AUTHORIZING THE REMAINING MEMBERS OF THE BRADLEY BOARD OF TRUSTEES TO CALL FOR A SPECIAL ELECTION FOR THE PURPOSE OF FILLING ALL VACANT OFFICES FOR THE REMAINDER OF THEIR UNEXPIRED TERM; SETTING A DATE FOR THE MUNICIPAL ELECTION; DIRECTING NOTICE BE GIVEN AND POSTED; AND ESTABLISHING THE QUALIFICATIONS FOR NOMINATIONS AND ELECTIONS.

WHEREAS, a vacancy has occurred in Ward 2 following the resignation of the representative of said Ward.

WHEREAS, the Board of Trustees may appoint or direct an election be held for filling the vacancy in said Ward.

WHEREAS, the Board of Trustees desires to hold a special election to fill the vacancy in the seat for Ward 2 for the remainder of the unexpired term.

NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT RESOLVED by the Board of Trustees that the Mayor of the Town of Bradley is hereby authorized and directed, pursuant to 11 O.S. §§ 8-109 and 16-112 and 16-304 and 16-315, to call a special election to be held in the Town of Bradley, State of Oklahoma, at the Bradley Community Building on the 11th day of July, 2023, concurrent with or immediately following the ~~special~~ town meeting that same date at 7:00 p.m.

NOW, BE IT FURTHER RESOLVED that the vacancy of Ward 2 shall be filled by election, with the elected officer serving out the unexpired term for said Ward until 20 .

NOW, BE IT FURTHER RESOLVED that each candidate must be a qualified elector by virtue of being a resident and registered voter within the municipality, or in the ward if an office is from a ward, for at least six (6) months prior to accepting nomination at the special town meeting.

NOW, BE IT FURTHER RESOLVED that the Town Clerk shall give notice of said ~~special~~ town meeting and special election by posting notice of the same with the date, time, place, and agenda at least ten (10) days before the election in five (5) places within the Town of Bradley.
