The Town Attorney Bailey Barberstated that the contract with either company could only be from one fiscal year to the next as the Town of Bradley is not allowed to enter into indebtedness in multi year contracts. Earl Cox made a motion to take a vote on the contracts, Dean Beverly 2nd the motion to vote and Zanna Farley voted yes to voting. 
