

ORDINANCE NO. .1

AN ORDINANCE OF THE BOARD OF TRUSTEES OF THE TOWN OF BRADLEY,
GRADY COUNTY, OKLAHOMA, VACATING THE HEREINAFTER DESCRIBED
PROPERTY RETAINING UTILITY RIGHTS AND DECLARING AN EMERGENCY

BE IT ORDAINED BY THE BOARD OF TRUSTEES OF THE TOWN OF BRADLEY, GRADY COUNTY,
OKLAHOMA

SECTION 1. That all of that part of Parker Avenue west to the town limits west of the west side of Cochran Avenue in said town, be, and the same is hereby, vacated and abandoned, and the platt of the said Town of Bradley, Grady County, Oklahoma, is hereby amended accordingly. Provided however, that any utility rights which may exist at this time in said vacated avenue be retained by the said town.

SECTION 2. It being immediately necessary for the preservation of the public peace, health and safety of the Town of Bradley, Grady County, Oklahoma, that an emergency be declared.

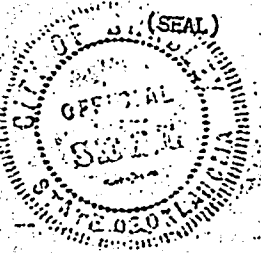
WHEREFORE, an emergency is hereby declared to exist and this ordinance shall be in full force and effect immediately from and after its passage, approval and publication.
