NEW COUNTIES.

Of the Indian Territory, as Authorized in the Bill to Divide the Territory.

Where in today's paper we give a rough, but fairly accurate map of the four counties in the northwest part of the territory in which we are interested, that of the Nineteenth, Twentieth, Twenty-first and Twenty-second. Our facilities and interest do not allow us to go farther. This is the twenty-second county, and Bradley is named as the county seat. It is a place of only a few inhabitants, has no claim even as a central location, has no railroad, has no commercial facilities and is far from being a desirable or proper place.

A glance at the map will show at once that Chickasha is the one point that could lay a just claim to the county seat. It is almost central north and south, is three miles from the west line, is the largest place in the limits, has commercial advantages not possessed by any other and should have been named as the county seat but the bill has named Bradley as the place, and it is going to take work to undo the prestige thus established. It is time to be up and doing.

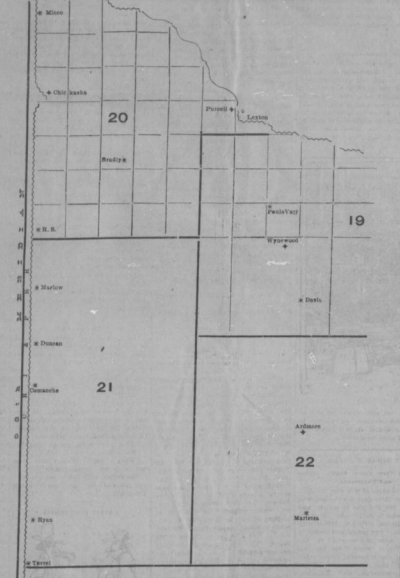
There may be no particular fear that the bill will pass at this short session, but there is nothing. The Indian Territory question is a burning one, and legislation is being done, and Chickasha wants to settle the question of the county seat of county twenty-second. It is time to be up and doing.

The reader will have to imagine the Canadian river following the ragged edge along the north border. We give also the counties blank to the south and east of this. It is our intention to give the county in which our interest lies.

NINETEENTH COUNTY.
 Commencing at a point where the meridian line between ranges three and four east crosses the Canadian river; thence south with said meridian line to the township line between townships one and two south; thence west with said township line to the meridian line between ranges two and three west of the Indian meridian; thence north with said meridian line to the township line between townships five and six north; thence east with said township line to the Canadian river; thence down the Canadian river, following the meanderings thereof, to the place of beginning.

TWENTIETH COUNTY.
 Commencing at a point where the township line between townships one and six north crosses the Canadian river; thence west with said township line to the meridian line between ranges two and three west of the base line; thence south on said meridian line to the township line between townships two and three north of the base line; thence west on said line to the township line to the boundary line

of the Indian territory; thence north with said western boundary line to the Canadian river; thence down said Canadian river to place of beginning.

TWENTY-FIRST COUNTY.
 Commencing at a point where the township line between townships two and three north crosses the meridian line between ranges two and three west of the Indian meridian; thence south with said meridian line to the Red river; thence up the Red river, following the meanderings thereof, to the western boundary line of the Indian territory; thence north with said boundary line to the township line, between townships two and three north; thence east with said township line to the place of beginning.

TWENTY-SECOND COUNTY.
 Commencing at a point where the township line between townships one and two south crosses the meridian line between ranges three and four east; thence south with said meridian line to the Red river; thence up Red river, following the meanderings thereof, to the meridian line between ranges two and three west; thence north with said meridian line to the township line between townships one and two south; thence west on said line to the township line to the boundary line
